

A Summary of One Time Funding Grants from the Ministry of Children and Family Development and Ministry of Education 2006/2007

In the past few months the BC Government has announced a number of one-time-only funding grants to child and family serving agencies, professional associations and other organizations.

As of March 31, 2007 the BC Government states it will have spent \$86M in one-timeonly early learning and child care related expenditures. These funds come from the now cancelled Early Learning and Child Care Bi-lateral Agreement that the BC Government stated had to be spent by the end of the last fiscal year. While some formal announcements have been made much of the funding for a number of these one-timeonly grants have yet to be publicly reported

First Call is aware that many sectors in this field are struggling to provide quality early learning and child care programs for children and families in their communities and that new initiatives can have real value. However, research and community consultations tell us, that the province needs to prioritize increased and ongoing investments to sustain existing services given their fragility and fragmentation. In the child care field, one-time-only grants only provide short term solutions without addressing the crucial need to reduce parent fees, enhance quality through sustained, affordable training and improved compensation, and increase the number of affordable child care spaces.
