What can you do?

3. Tell your elected representatives – your provincial MLA and federal MP that we are counting on them to support :
 - legislation to ensure five key principles -- quality, universality, inclusion, accessibility, and developmental programming;
 - funding that will move child care in Canada from a user fee and subsidy patchwork to a publicly funded, pan-Canadian child care system;
 - stronger accountability so that our province uses all federal child care funds in addition to provincial child care funding to build a universal child care system.
