On February 6th, 2012, two members of the Coalition of Child Care Advocates of BC will report to the United Nations working group to the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC).

After submitting our brief, *[A Tale of Two Canadas: Implementing Rights in Early Childhood](#)*, to the committee, Lynell Anderson and Susan Harney were honoured to be invited to appear before the committee to discuss the crisis in child care in BC and the rest of Canada.

The appearance at the United Nations is the culmination of two years of work in BC and across Canada with our partner, the [Child Care Advocacy Association of Canada](#), on our Child Care is a Right project.

Four or five other organizations will also appear before the committee to discuss a wide range of issues related to the rights of children in Canada.

While in Geneva, Susan and Lynell will meet with a number of international advocacy organizations to share strategies and solutions including our *Plan For a Public System of Integrated Early Care and Learning*.
